The **2022-2023 Georgia Student Health Survey** will be administered soon. Survey participation for STUDENTS is *voluntary*. Please note that the Georgia Student Health Survey is an anonymous, statewide survey instrument that identifies school climate issues that impact student achievement. In order to provide a safe and supportive learning environment for your child, the Georgia Department of Education collects survey information at the elementary level from 3rd - 5th grade students. The survey includes 15 school climate questions and should take no more than 10-15 minutes. A form was sent home last week to request permission for your student to participate in the survey. Please return the form by 1/27/23 **ONLY if you DO NOT** wish your child to participate.

In addition, the **2022-2023 Georgia Parent Survey** is now available for you to complete. Survey participation is voluntary, but we strongly encourage participation in the survey to provide us with critically important data to help guide prevention and intervention strategies. Your input is vital to the growth and improvement efforts at Thomas Crossroads. This information gets reported to the state on how our school is doing. PLEASE, PLEASE take the time to complete the electronic. The link was sent out last week on Remind, but you can also find it on our school website.

A NOTE FROM COACH WOODS:

As part of your child's P.E. program, TCE is taking part in the <u>FITNESSGRAM</u> physical fitness assessment. This assessment began in November and goes to the end of the year. Please make sure your child is dressed for P.E to be able to participate in these assessments. All students grades 1st – 5th will participate in this assessment. 1st - 3rd grades will *only* do **height** & **weight**.

<u>FITNESSGRAM</u> was selected by the GA Dept. of Education because it measures only those areas of fitness related to the health of students. These areas include: cardiovascular endurance, muscular strength & endurance, flexibility, and body composition. The <u>FITNESSGRAM</u> assessment does *not* compare your child to anyone else, nor does it measure skill or athletic performance. Rather, it compares your child to health standards that have been established by researchers as the level of fitness all students should reach in order to attain health benefits. After your child has completed the <u>FITNESSGRAM</u> you will receive a student report that includes the following:

- · A brief explanation of each fitness assessment
- · Details on the importance of each assessment
- The child's actual scores & the Healthy Fitness Zone (HFZ) for the child's gender and age
- An explanation of the HFZ & the student report.

Please use the report as a tool to support your child in leading a healthy & active life-style. A few ways to support your elementary child include:

- · Stress the impact fitness has on feeling good
- Give your child equipment that encourages physical activity
- Help your child identify a time & place for daily physical activity
- Spend less time on screens (TV, video games, devices, etc.)
- · Teach your child games you enjoyed as a child
- Praise and encourage your child to be active
